

When will the Library Open?

Starting August 4th the library will be open by appointment during the following hours.

Monday: Closed

Tuesday-Friday: 10am-8pm Saturday-Sunday: 1pm-5pm

How can I use MPCL?

All are welcome to visit and browse the Library. In order to access electronic materials, check out physical materials and use MPCL computers and other resources, a library card must be obtained. MPCL library cards are free and only require identification and proof of address. Temporary cards can be obtained on the MPCL website and permanent cards can be obtained at the Library.

What does the future hold for MPCL?

MPCL is just getting started! The Library will be housed in its temporary Blooms Park location for the first few years, however the Library's collection, programs and events will expand over time and is expected to relocate to a bigger, more modern facility in downtown Manassas Park in 2023. Community feedback and interests will help drive future programs and services at MPCL.

What services are available during COVID?




